KENTUCKY STATE FAIR ENTRY DEADLINE IS JULY 1

What: The deadline for the Kentucky State Fair general entries is **Tuesday, July 1**. Registration is available online now at www.kystatefair.org. Forms are also available online as a PDF and can be mailed once completed. Entries must be postmarked by July 1. Late entries will be accepted with a fee until Thursday, July 10.

The Kentucky State Fair is an 11-day celebration of the history, heritage and culture of the Bluegrass State. More than 600,000 attend America's largest indoor fair, which uses over 1.2 million square feet of contiguous exhibit space at the Kentucky Exposition Center. While its roots are in agriculture, the Kentucky State Fair has grown into a trade and public education exposition, as well as a major entertainment venue. The World's Championship Horse Show, held during the Fair, is the world's richest and most prestigious Saddlebred show. Attendees and exhibitors contribute over \$16.8 million annually in economic impact. The Kentucky State Fair & World's Championship Horse Show are owned and produced by the Kentucky State Fair Board, an agency of the Kentucky Tourism, Arts and Heritage Cabinet.
