PREPPERS AND SURIVALISTS HEAD TO LOUISVILLE FOR EDUCATIONAL EXPOSITION

LOUISVILLE, KY (October 1, 2015) – The National Preppers and Survivalists Expo is coming to the Kentucky Exposition Center Saturday, October 10 – Sunday, October 11 with everything needed to prepare for any disaster big or small. The expo will be held in the East Hall and feature more than 150 exhibits, more than 50 instructional classes and is expected to draw 8,000 attendees.

Daily classes include courses that vary from medical information to food preparation and storage, including sessions on emergency first-aid, prepping for short term and long term disasters, water purification, long term food storage and more.

Numerous famous survivalists and authors will be at the expo, including Dave Canterbury from "Duel Survivor" and Brenton Burns from "Doomsday Castle." Authors include N.E. MacDougald, author of "Fortune Guide to Surviving the Apocalypse: the Ultimate Guide to Protecting Your Family from Societal Collapse" and Jim Cobb who has written a number of books including "Prepper's Home Defense," "The Prepper's Complete Book of Disaster Readiness" and "Prepper's Long-Term Survival Guide."

For an additional fee attendees can take a hands-on suture class from Dr. Joe Alton, aka Dr. Bones and Amy Alton aka Nurse Amy. Together, they're the authors of the No. 1 Amazon bestseller in Survival Skills and Safety/First Aid "The Survival Medicine Handbook."

Show hours are 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. on Saturday and 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. on Sunday. Tickets are \$10 for a one-day pass at the door, \$15 for a two-day pass at the door and \$60 for a family four-pack two-day pass at the door. Discounted tickets are available online in advance. Parking at the Kentucky Exposition Center is \$8 per vehicle.

ABOUT PARKING

Conveniently located adjacent to the Louisville International Airport and near the junction of three major

interstates, the Kentucky Exposition Center is easily accessible and just five minutes south of downtown Louisville. The spacious grounds have 19,000 parking spaces and is accessible from six gates surrounding the facility. Gates are located off of Phillips Lane, Crittenden Drive and Preston Highway.
